

Sermon Text: Luke 16:13

Sermon Title: Are You Greedy?

Main Idea:

Jesus wants us to think about our relationship with money. We've already seen that it is a tool we can use to invest in eternity, that it is a test of our true character. Today, we are going to see that money can be a serious spiritual threat. Specifically, we consider what makes money dangerous, how to evaluate how you are doing in the face of that danger, and what you can do to protect yourself from being enslaved to money.

2. Why does the Bible both speak positively about money and also offer so many cautions regarding money?
3. How can money function as both a tool and a test in our spiritual lives?
4. Why is money considered a potential spiritual threat, according to the passage?
5. What does it mean for money to be an idol in someone's life?
6. How can individuals identify whether money has become an idol in their lives?
7. What practical steps can we take to ensure we use money in a God-honoring way?
8. What are some ways throughout Luke that Jesus emphasizes the spiritual dangers of money in His teachings about discipleship?
9. What are the consequences of placing trust in money over God, as outlined in the message?
10. What are some ways you need to change as a result of this series of messages on money?
